1. The completed form shall be returned to the Club Treasurer, together with a cheque made payable to the Thousand Islands Yacht Club of, for 2017, either \$380Cdn or \$330US (may vary with exchange rate), to TIYC Treasurer, Philip Mason, 39 Rosebery Ave., Ottawa, K1S 1W1, Ontario.
  2. The Treasurer shall inform the Club's executive of the application, and if acceptable to them, he shall then confirm with the sponsors and circulate the applicants name(s) to the membership. If after 14 days no objections are received, the applicants will be accepted as members and invited to be initiated at the subsequent initiation meeting of the club. New members are required to be initiated by the end of the subsequent year of being accepted as members or their membership may be rescinded without refund.
  3. If objections are raised, the Club's executive will convene and decide on an appropriate course of action.
  4. Each application must be sponsored by two current members of the club or, if the applicant does not know two members, then one member and someone in the boating/sailing community who can vouch for them.
  5. The membership year runs from 1 January through 31 December All new members are required to complete the Membership Payment Form each year to remain active members but, since the initial membership fee covers three years, additional membership dues are not required until the fourth year. You are a member until you formally notify the Club that you are leaving. Therefore you are required to pay fourth year and subsequent year dues each year until you formally leave. Any yearly lapses must be made good in subsequent years.
  6. By signing this membership form, you, if accepted as a member(s) of The Thousand Islands Yacht Club, formally acknowledge that the Club is run by volunteers and you agree not to hold any Club volunteers liable, legally or otherwise, in the event of an accident, mishap or problem that may arise at any Club event, race or social gathering.
